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PROJECT: Postive Effect



Quilters often give their time and talents to make quilts for charity. The instructions include yardage and cutting lists for four popular charity sizes (in addition to the original quilt size).

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

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CUT FABRICS

Choose your quilt size on the chart on page 3. Referring to the chart, cut needed materials.

ASSEMBLE BLOCKS

- 1. Gather four matching 5" squares from one print, four matching 3½×5" rectangles from a second print, and a solid tan 3½" square.
- 2. Lay out pieces in three horizontal rows (Block Assembly Diagram). Sew together pieces in rows. Press seams toward rectangles. Join rows to make a block. The block should be 121/2" square including seam allowances.
- **3.** Repeat to make number of blocks indicated in the Materials chart on *page 3* for chosen quilt size.

ASSEMBLE QUILT TOP

- 1. Referring to Quilt Assembly
 Diagram, lay out blocks and solid tan
 2½×12½" sashing rectangles in number
 of horizontal rows indicated in chart on
 page 3. Sew together pieces in rows. Press
 seams toward sashing rectangles. Cut
 and piece (if necessary) solid tan 2½×42"
 strips for sashing to make sashing strips
 in lengths indicated in chart on page 3.
 Join block rows and sashing strips to
 make quilt center. Press seams toward
 sashing strips.
- 2. Cut and piece (if necessary) solid tan 2½×42″ strips for border to make border strips in lengths indicated in chart on page 3. Sew long border strips to long edges of quilt center. Add short border strips to remaining edges to complete quilt top. Press all seams toward border.

FINISH QUILT

- **1.** Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste.
- **2.** Quilt as desired. Nicole Christoffersen machine-quilted interlocking circles across the quilt top (Quilting Diagram).
- **3.** Bind with navy blue print binding strips.

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






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Block Assembly Diagram
