



## TOSSED COIN QUILT

This quilt has a solid color (or reads solid) kit, including a total of eight strips of 45" each. Six are side borders to the pieced columns; two are top and bottom borders. There is also enough fabric to cut approximately 60 blocks or "coins" 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square.

Select fabric strips in all sizes. All are 2 1/2" wide. Lengths are -- Small strips - 4" to 6". Medium strips - 6" to 10". Long strips - 10" to 14". pieced strips. You will be piecing strip columns to be the same length as the solid strips, a total of 15 pieced strips.

Arrange strips lengthwise in random order, both by color and length. Place one coin between each strip. Plan for 3 to 5 coins per column with an average of four coins. Sew strips and coins together to make a 45" column. Continue to arrange the second column of strips, making sure that fabrics are staggered and coins are not placed side by side. Continue to make all 15 pieced strips.

Sew three strips together to form long block. Sew solid strip to each side. Continue with next three pieced strips and one solid strip and continue the process until all are attached. Sew top and bottom borders. If there is not enough border fabric, sew contrasting blocks on each corner of border.

Quilt should be 46" - 47" long when finished.
