

## Block of the Month: Christmas Gift

Cutting for (1) 12 ½" X 12 ½" unfinished block.

Background: White on white or white

2 @ 2 ½" X 2 ½" squares

1 @ 2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangle

1 @ 2 ½" X 8 ½" rectangle

2 @ 2 ½" X 12 ½" rectangles

Flying Goose Bow: Christmas Colors (Solids)

2 @ 2 ½" X 2 ½" squares

Christmas Package (Prints, Stripes, Dots, etc.)

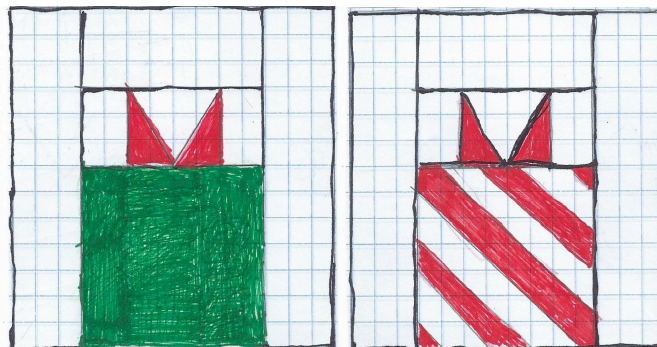
1 @ 8 ½" X 8 ½" square

(Note: The size must remain the same but have fun making the Christmas Package.

Play with the fabric making it diagonal stripes

or

looking like ribbon crisscrossing, etc.).



\* Make Bow:

- Take the (1) 2 ½" X 4 ½" white rectangle. Place (1) 2 ½" X 2 ½" Solid Color Square on right top. Sew down using the snowball method. Trim and Press. Repeat on the left top. Trim and Press.
- Attach (1) 2 ½" X 2 ½" white square to both sides of the flying goose bow.
- Attach (1) 2 ½" X 8 ½" rectangle to the top of the bow unit.

\* Block Assembly:

- Sew the bow unit to the (1) 8 ½" X 8 ½" Christmas Package square.
- Sew (1) 2 ½" X 12 ½" white rectangle to each side of the Christmas Package square.
