

## BLOCK of the Month: Let's go...Pick CLOVERS!

**COLORS:** GREEN CLOVERS with WHITE ON WHITE (WOW) BACKGROUND

**CUTTING for 10 1/2" unfinished blocks:**

**3-LEAF CLOVER:** GREEN (4) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" WHITE ON WHITE (WOW) (9) 2" x 2" and (2) 5" x 5"

**4-LEAF CLOVER:** GREEN (4) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" WHITE ON WHITE (WOW) (12) 2" x 2"

**SEWING: 3-LEAF CLOVER** place one **WOW** 2" square on three corners of a **GREEN** square, right sides together, to snowball the corners, as per diagram. Draw line on wrong side of **WOW** 2" squares, corner to corner, sew on drawn lines, trim 1/4" away from drawn lines, press to corners, as per diagram. Place one **WOW** 5" square on corner of remaining **GREEN** square, right sides together, to snowball the corner, as per diagram. Same process as with small squares. Repeat with remaining **WOW** 5" square for opposite corner to create stem of **CLOVER**. Sew three **GREEN** and stem blocks together as per diagram. **4-LEAF CLOVER:** snowball three corners of all four **GREEN** squares, skip the stem. Sew together as per diagram.

Make a **3-LEAF** or a **4-LEAF CLOVER**. You can use any type of **GREEN** fabric for the **CLOVERS**, St. Patrick's Day prints are perfect, or any other **GREEN** print or solid. Use **WHITE** or **WHITE ON WHITE** for your background and you will be sure to have good luck when putting these quick blocks together.
