



RAIL FENCE QUILT

This quilt is made with 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips. Arrange 5 strips side by side and sew together with 1/4" seams. This will make a 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" block. The number of blocks needed will vary according to the size of quilt desired. A 50" square lap quilt will be 25 blocks. Each block

should have one dark color on the outside strip. Arrange blocks together so that the dark strips form a zig-zag pattern and sew.

Tip - alternate strips from light and dark; alternate color patterns

RAIL FENCE QUILT VARIATION

Sew five 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips together to make a 10 1/2" block (block A). Sew two strips together to make a 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" (block B). Arrange block A to Block B with one in vertical direction and the other horizontal. Sew together. This block is 10 1/2 x 14 1/2". For a lap quilt, make a total of 12 blocks with three blocks wide and four down. Finish with a border.
