BLOCK of the Month: Let's go... Sew with Spools of Thread!

COLORS: STRIPED = thread, BROWN = wooden spool and WHITE ON WHITE (WOW) = background

CUTTING for 9 ½" unfinished block:

STRIPED

(1) 5 ½" x 5 ½"

BROWN: (2) 2 ½" x 9 ½" WHITE ON WHITE (WOW) (4) 2 ½" x 2 ½" (2) 2 ½" x 5 ½"

SEWING: Place one WOW 2 1/2" square at each end of one BROWN strip, right sides together, as per diagram. Draw line on wrong side of WOW 2 1/2" squares, corner to corner, sew on drawn lines, as per diagram. NOTE: Drawn lines go opposite directions from each other! Trim 1/4" away from drawn lines. press to corners. Repeat with two remaining WOW 2 1/2" squares and BROWN strip. Sew one WOW 2 1/2" x 5 ½" to each side of STRIPED 5 ½" square, right sides together, making sure STRIPES are horizontal, as per diagram. Sew BROWN pieced sections to top and bottom of STRIPED section, making sure WOW touches **WOW**, as per diagram.

You can make the thread part of your block from any striped fabric to represent variegated thread. If you do not have striped fabrics, you can also use any fabric that reads as a solid to represent single colored thread. Doesn't every quilter need a sewing themed quilt? I sure do!
